

Announcement of Office of Contemporary Art and Culture Subject: Artist Application to Join the 2020 Project "YOUNG ARTISTS TALENT #11"

The Office of Contemporary Art and Culture, Ministry of Culture of Thailand, has scheduled a development program for young artists for the year 2020, under the name "YOUNG ARTISTS TALENT #11". The program aims to support young and emerging contemporary artists with outstanding work and readiness in producing contemporary artworks. 70 to 80 selected individuals from domestic and international educational institutions from ASEAN+3 countries will be invited to participate in workshops and an art competition in Nakhon Ratchasima Province, Thailand. 10 to 12 talented young and emerging artists will then be selected to join an overseas advanced workshop program and field trip to USA. The artists are anticipated to receive a world's outlook to expand their imagination and to promote their artistic creativity. With an opportunity to learn from world-leading artists, all selected young and emerging artists are encouraged to develop critical and technical approach and to produce an exhibition at Ratchadamnoen Contemporary Art Center to display their works as the final outcome of the program. The schedule and details are as follows:

1. Works

Paintings, sculptures, printmaking, and mixed media artworks which express the artist's creativity and uniqueness, are accepted. The suggested dimension is no larger than 100 cm. on any size.

2. Eligible Applicants

<u>For domestic applicants</u>: Applicants must be in the third year, or above, of their undergraduate studies in any related field, including painting, sculpture, printmaking and mixed media. Applicants must be Thai citizens and Thai residents under the age of 30 years (born after December 31st 1990).

In case an applicant is holding a pending registered status for military service, The Office of Contemporary Art and Culture may exempt the applicants from participation in the field trip and exhibition in the USA.

The Office of Contemporary Art and Culture reserves the right to reject applications from those who have already participated in previous overseas Young Artists Talent programs.

For international applicants: Applicants must be in the final year of their undergraduate studies in any related field, including painting, sculpture, printmaking and mixed media. Applicants must be citizens and residents of any ASEAN+3 countries under the age of 30 years (born after December 31st 1990).

The Office of Contemporary Art and Culture reserves the right to exempt the applicants who are unable to commit to travel at scheduled dates from participation in the field trip and exhibition in the USA.

3. Submission

An applicant must submit one CD-Rom, labeled with his or her full names, institution names, and the province or location name on the disc or the case cover. All original documents must be sent by post with the CD-ROM, which comprise all of the following:

3.1 A filled application form (Document no.1) with attachments as follows:

- One complete Curriculum Vitae (CV) which is readable on Microsoft Office Word using any Cordia font. The file name must be in format:

- One certified copy of applicant's Identification Card (original)
- One original confirmation letter of student status from applicant's

educational institution (original)

3.2 Photographs of three to five applicant's previous works (an image file size should be between two to seven MB) the page format must follow the given template (Document no.2). The titles of the artworks, sizes, techniques and description should be provided, which must not exceed one half of an A4 page. The file must be readable on Microsoft Office Word using any Cordia font. The image file must be in .doc and .pdf in name format:

3.3 One sketch of a newly-designed artwork in name format:

After the decision in the first round is made, selected applicants must produce the proposed works according to the sketch to enter the second round. The decision from the judges, under the theme of "Art Happiness", will be made in Nakhon Ratchasima Province.

3.4 Applicants can submit their applications by hand or post to "Art Center" Office of Contemporary Art and Culture, Ministry of Culture, No. 10 Thiam Ruam Mit Road, Huai Khwang Sub-district, Huai Khwang District, Bangkok 10310, Thailand. The envelope should be labeled "YOUNG ARTISTS TALENT #11 (2020)". For more details, applicants can contact the Art Center directly by phone at (+66) 209 3755. The submission deadline is December 12th 2019 (received date).

4. Selection

4.1 For the first round, the judges will make their decisions from the applicants' documents and their previous works (as per section 3 of this announcement). The Office of Contemporary Art and Culture reserves the right to reject applications with incomplete documents. 70 to 80 successful applicant names will be announced at the scheduled date.

4.2 For the second round, The judges will consider two submitted works and the conduct of each candidate during the participation in the program. 10 to 12 selected candidates will be invited to join the field trip and exhibition in the USA. The details of the works are as follows:

4.2.1 One artwork under the theme "Art Happiness", where the applicants must submit one completed work on the first date of participation. The work should respond to the submitted sketch in the first round.

4.2.2 One artwork that is created during the workshop period in Nakhon Ratchasima Province which represents the candidates' artistic statements and techniques, reflecting their enhanced creativity. Please note that the submitted works will not be returned to the candidate.
